## Tip

**Password Login:** To make it that you need to enter your password before entering your account in OS X, go to *System Preferences*. Under *Personal*, Select *Security*. Finally, under *For all accounts on this computer*, select *Disable automatic login*.

Some preferences can require you to click the lock icon at the bottom of the window and type in a password of an administrator account (I believe) before changing. To have this happen every time this is possible, go to *System Preferences*. Under *Personal*, Select *Security*. Finally, under *For all accounts on this computer*, select *Require password to unlock each secure system preference*. With this selected, your settings re-lock automatically after exiting *System Preferences*. If this option is not selected, you can re-lock them manually by clicking on the open lock at the bottom of a settings windows with lockable settings.
